Your application must include the following information:

1. **Title of presentation/ workshop**
2. **Session Type** (Keynote, single presentation, shared presentation, workshop)
3. **Length of session** (Keynote -40 min or Single/shared presentation 20mins) min, workshop 30 or 60mins)
4. **Presenter name(s)**
5. **Presenter's position and workplace/ company**
6. **Abstract.** A summary of 100 – 150 words describing the issue/ presentation. Abstracts will be used in the Conference Program.

GUIDELINES

- You may submit more than one abstract.
- Although many presentations use PowerPoint, its use is not a prerequisite. We encourage presenters to use other media such as film, photos etc.
- Presentations will be delivered as addresses of 20minutes. Presenters are encouraged to allow for and promote discussion; therefore presentations should be planned for 20 minutes plus a discussion time of 5 minutes duration.
- The 20 minute session time will be strictly adhered to.
- Workshops can be extended to 60 minutes.

The invitation to submit an abstract does not constitute an offer to pay travel, accommodation or registration costs associated with the Conference.

Speakers will have the option to register and attend the Conference for a reduced rate (speaker rate).
